Scarlett's Second Chance

In September, we rescued Scarlett, a chestnut mare who was severely underweight. Her bones were starkly visible, a heartbreaking sign of neglect. Our team acted swiftly, starting her on a refeeding schedule—1.5 pounds of hay every three hours, day and night—and gradually increasing her intake.

As Scarlett gains weight, her beauty and personality are shining through. She still needs to gain about 200 pounds, but her playful, attention-loving nature shows she's happy and thriving. Despite her past hardships, Scarlett is a remarkably personable mare. She thrives on attention and seems genuinely happy.

Scarlett's story reminds us why we do this work. Without intervention, horses like her might not get a second chance. We're proud to be part of Scarlett's journey and can't wait to see her continue to heal and grow.
